Hugh Rogers, AM, BCom was instrumental in founding the Melbourne Boston Sisters Association in 1985. To honour Hugh's outstanding contribution to the life of both cities the Association has created three named Fellowships to encourage exchanges by supporting promising young researchers and practitioners. Selected by a panel of prominent experts, three scholarships are to be awarded annually, one each in Medical Research, The Arts and Education.

Boston Arts Academy is the only arts secondary college in Boston. Three outstanding young students accompanied by the Deputy Principal of the Academy will spend two weeks attending VCA Secondary School and learning about Melbourne and Australia. We anticipate the visit will be a formative experience for the students.
